### **MCL undertakes Flood Relief Measures**

Dedicated teams of Mahanadi Coalfields Limited worked days together to assuage the hardship and havoc caused by the overflowing Mahanadi in Sambalpur, Lakhanpur Area of Jharsuguda and parts of Angul district.

**JHARSUGUDA:** A three member team from Lakhanpur Area distributed food materials consisting of Rice(200 kgs), Dal(300 kgs), Chuda(600 kgs), Gud(300 kgs), Salt(250 kgs), Sugar(100 kgs), Biscuits(1008 pkts), Match boxes( Carton), Tea(10 kgs), Milk Powder(10kgs), Potato( 15 bags), Onion(5 bags) & water pouches(5000 Nos) in addition to Lanterns(30), Umbrellas(30), Torch lights(30), Mosquito Coil(Carton) and Candles(300 pkts), to 19 enclaves of Jharsuguda district on the 10<sup>th</sup> of September 2011. Two truckload of coal was also given to the 19 enclaves there. Besides the above, the Mahila Mandal distributed clothes and biscuits at the relief camps there.

**SAMBALPUR :** MCL donated a cheque of Rs 1.00 lac to the Collector, Sambalpur for distribution of clothing at Sambalpur. Food materials were purchased and distributed through the self help groups at Sambalpur. To drain out the water, MCL first installed 3 Nos of large pumps brought in from its mines at Belpahar, Bharatpur and MCL Hq. Subsequently 15Nos of pumps were procured on urgent basis from Kolkata and handed over to Sub-Collector, Sambalpur. In addition to the above, MCL had earlier supplied 20 Nos of Anti Larva Spraying Machine, 100 Nos of spades, 100 broom sets and has placed the order for 30 Nos. of wheel barrows to facilitate the cleaning process in Sambalpur town. MCL has also agreed to re-imburse the wages for 100 nos of manpower , hire chgs of 2 Nos. of JCB's and 5 Nos. of Hywa / 10 Tractors for a period of 2 months.

**ANGUL:** MCL facilitated the supply of food materials in the Athmalik, Kishore Nagar and Angul Block in Angul district. A team from Jagannath Area of MCL procured Rice (500 kgs), Chuda(300 Kgs), Gud(50 kgs), Dal(100 kgs), Baby Milk Powder Biscuits, Candles & Matchboxes, Mosquito coils, 300 Sarees and 100 Dhoti's for distribution.
